Insurers are focusing on strategies for meeting this quality measure to help reduce preventable adverse effects in the elderly. For example, Medicare Part D prescription drug plans are being evaluated on whether their elderly patients are taking any high-risk medications. For this reason, some plans may also limit coverage for some of these medications.
