Proportion of Days Covered: Renin Angiotensin System Antagonists (PDC-RASA)

Description

- The percentage of individuals 18 years and older who met the Proportion of Days Covered (PDC) threshold of 80% for Renin Angiotensin System (RAS) antagonists during the measurement period.
- Eligible patients must:
 - Be ≥ 18 years of age
 - Have a treatment period ≥ 91 days*
 - Have ≥ 2 claims on different dates of service for any RAS antagonist



Calculation

NUMERATOR =

The number of eligible patients with adherence to RAS antagonists $\geq 80\%$

DENOMINATOR =

The number of eligible patients



Did You Know?¹

- The 2017 ACC/AHA Clinical Practice Guidelines define two stages of hypertension based on systolic blood pressure (SBP) and diastolic blood pressure (DBP).
- Stage 1: SBP 130-139 mm Hg or DBP 80-89 mm Hg
- Stage 2: SBP ≥ 140 mm Hg or DBP ≥ 90 mm Hg

Exclusions

- Sacubitril/Valsartan claims during the treatment period
- Enrolled in Hospice
- End-Stage Renal Disease (ESRD)
- More than a 1-day gap in enrollment during the treatment period

Therapeutic Categories Include:

- Direct Renin Inhibitors
- Angiotensin II Receptor Blockers (ARBs)
- Angiotensin-Converting Enzyme (ACE) Inhibitors



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
