## Proportion of Days Covered: Diabetes All Class (PDC-DR)

## **Description**

- The percentage of individuals 18 years and older who met the Proportion of Days Covered (PDC) threshold of 80% for diabetes medications during the measurement period.
- Eligible patients must:
  - o Be ≥ 18 years of age
  - o Have a treatment period ≥ 91 days\*
  - o Have ≥ 2 claims on different dates of service for any diabetes medication



## Did You Know?1

- Metformin is the first-line medication for patients with type-2 diabetes.

## **Calculation**

#### NUMERATOR =

The number of eligible patients with a diabetes medication adherence of  $\geq 80\%$ 

#### **DENOMINATOR =**

The number of eligible patients

### **Exclusions**

- Insulin claims during the treatment period
- Enrolled in hospice
- End-Stage Renal Disease (ESRD)
- More than a 1-day gap in enrollment during the treatment period
